## Sevens in the Cosmology of Moses

The number 7 is deeply symbolic in the Jewish tradition. Seven days of creation. Sabbath. The Babylonians used a seven day system. Possible influence lunar quarter phases (~7 days)  
Number of Classic Planets: Moon, Mercury, Venus, Earth, Mars, Jupiter, Saturn.

## The Sevens of the Book of Revelation of John

The number Seven is mentioned 54 to 57 times in the Book of Revelation, depending on the translation.

Symbolizing Completeness, Perfection, and the Total Fulfillment of Prophecy.

### Key Occurrences

#### Seven churches/Messages/Angels: **The Revelation Titles of Jesus**

1. Ephesus: The words of him who holds the Seven stars in his right hand, who walks among the Seven golden lampstands.
2. Smyrna: The words of the First and the Last, who Died and Came to Life.
3. Pergamum: The words of Him who has the Sharp Two-edged Sword.
4. Thyatira: The words of the Son of God, who has Eyes like a Flame of fire, and whose feet are like Burnished Bronze.
5. Sardis: The words of him who has the Seven spirits of God and the Seven stars.
6. Philadelphia: The words of the Holy One, the True One, who has the Key of David, who opens and no one will shut, who shuts and no one opens.
7. Laodicea: The words of Amen, faithful & true witness, the Beginning of God's creation.

#### Seven: Seals, Trumpets, Bowls, Spirits, Lampstands, Stars

- **7 Blessings:** Found throughout the book (e.g., Rev 1:3; 22:7).
- **7 Horns/Eyes/Heads:** Describing the Lamb or beasts (Rev 5:6; 12:3; 17:7).
- **7 Angels/Thunders/Plagues:** (Rev 8:2; 10:3; 15:1).
