

A chiasm (or chiastic structure) is a literary pattern in which ideas are arranged symmetrically, often in an A–B–C–B'–A' form, with the main emphasis on the central part (C).

 Promise of blessing to nations Gen 12:3

D'. NEW COVENANT PEOPLE

Church from all nations Rev. 7:9
 Abrahamic promise fulfilled

E. EXODUS / REDEMPTION

Deliverance through blood →
 Passover Lamb (1446 BC) Ex 12 →
 Journey to promised inheritance →

E'. GREATER REDEMPTION

Salvation through the Lamb Rev 5:9, Rev. 7:14
 New Exodus Rev. 17-18
 Deliverance from sin and death

F. DAVIDIC KINGDOM

David the King (~1000 BC Psalms)
 Temple established (966 BC)
 God dwelling among His people
 Isaiah ~700 BC

F'. KINGDOM OF GOD

Christ the King Rev. 1:5
 Heavenly temple Rev. 3:12, 7:15, 11.9
 God dwelling with humanity

G. EXILE / JUDGMENT

Israel scattered (Return Babylon 538 BC)
 Temple destroyed (70 AD)

G'. RESTORATION

Return from exile fulfilled spiritually
 Gathering of God's people
 Return to Promised Land (May 14, 1948)
